PART 52—SOLICITATION PROVISIONS AND CONTRACT CLAUSES

1. The authority citation for 48 CFR Part 52 continues to read as follows:

Authority: 41 U.S.C. 486(c); 10 U.S.C. chapter 137; and 42 U.S.C. 2473(c).

2. In section 52.219–8, paragraph (c)(3) of the clause is revised to read as follows:

§ 52.219–8 Utilization of Small, Small Disadvantaged and Women-Owned Small Business Concerns.

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Utilization of Small Business Concerns (Jan. 1999)

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(3) Small business concern owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals means a small business concern that represents, as part of its offer, that it meets the definition of a small disadvantaged business concern in 13 CFR 124.1002.
