**Federal Travel Regulation; Maximum  
Per Diem Rates****AGENCY:** Office of Governmentwide  
Policy, GSA.**ACTION:** Final rule.

**SUMMARY:** An analysis of lodging and meal cost survey data reveals that the listing of maximum per diem rates for locations within the continental United States (CONUS) should be updated to provide for the reimbursement of Federal employees' expenses covered by per diem. This final rule increases/decreases the maximum lodging amounts in certain existing per diem localities, adds new per diem localities, and removes a number of previously designated per diem localities. In an effort to improve the efficiency of the per diem rate-setting process, GSA has switched the per diem rate changes from the traditional calendar year schedule to a fiscal year schedule. Thus, the annual change to per diem rates will coincide with the budget planning process. Therefore, beginning this year, the per diem rates will be effective on October 1, the start of the fiscal year.

**DATES:** This final rule is effective October 1, 2000, and applies for travel performed on or after October 1, 2000.

**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:****A. Background**

The General Services Administration (GSA), after an analysis of additional data, has determined that current lodging and meals and incidental expenses (M&IE) allowances for certain localities do not adequately reflect the cost of lodging in those areas. To provide adequate per diem reimbursement for Federal employee travel to those areas, the maximum per diem allowances are changed.

**B. Executive Order 12866**

GSA has determined that this final rule is not a significant regulatory action for the purposes of Executive Order 12866 of September 30, 1993.

**C. Regulatory Flexibility Act**

This final rule is not required to be published in the **Federal Register** for notice and comment; therefore, the Regulatory Flexibility Act, 5 U.S.C. 601 *et seq.*, does not apply.

**D. Paperwork Reduction Act**

The Paperwork Reduction Act does not apply because this final rule does not impose recordkeeping or information collection requirements, or the collection of information from offerors, contractors, or members of the public which require the approval of the Office of Management and Budget under 44 U.S.C. 501 *et seq.*

**E. Small Business Regulatory  
Enforcement Fairness Act**

This final rule is also exempt from congressional review prescribed under 5 U.S.C. 801 since it relates solely to agency management and personnel.

For the reasons set forth in the preamble, under 5 U.S.C. 5701-5709, 41 CFR chapter 301 is amended as follows:

1. Appendix A to chapter 301 is revised to read as follows:

**Appendix A to Chapter 301—  
Prescribed Maximum Per Diem Rates  
for CONUS**

The maximum rates listed below are prescribed under part 301-11 of this chapter for reimbursement of per diem expenses incurred during official travel within CONUS (the continental United States). The amount shown in column (a) is the maximum that will be reimbursed for lodging expenses excluding taxes. The M&IE rate shown in column (b) is a fixed amount allowed for meals and incidental expenses covered by per diem. The per diem payment calculated in accordance with part 301-11 of this chapter for lodging expenses plus the M&IE rate may not exceed the maximum per diem rate shown in column (c). Seasonal rates apply during the periods indicated. It is the policy of the Government, as reflected in the Hotel Motel Fire Safety Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-391, September 25, 1990 as amended by Public Law 105-85, November 18, 1997), referred to as "the Act" in this appendix, to save lives and protect property by promoting fire safety in hotels, motels, and all places of public accommodation affecting commerce. In furtherance of the Act's goals, employees are encouraged to stay in a facility which is fire-safe, *i.e.*, an approved accommodation, when commercial lodging is required. Other per diem localities listed in this appendix will be reviewed on an annual basis by GSA to determine whether rates are adequate.
